- 6. Discussion Contribution to Village Picnic

Following the successful picnic held in Woodman Close for the Queens Jubilee Cllr Cobbold had been asked by residents if the picnic might become an annual event and the parish council financially contribute. £500 had been made available for Jubilee picnic and councillors agreed that a similar amount be made available in 2017.

7. Discussion – Community benefits arising from planning application 10/00895/FUL (Erection of three 11kw 13 metre diameter Gaia twin blade wind turbines, mounted on free-standing 18m galvanised steel masts on 5m2 concrete bases with associated control boxes Kirton Farm House Stockbridge Road Crawley Winchester Hampshire SO21 2PJ)

The clerk had contacted Kirton Farm as clerk to Crawley Parish Council and had confirmed that the three local parishes adjacent to the site could each potentially benefit from a donation based on electricity produced by the turbines to be spent on sustainability projects within the community. To date this donation amounted to £2,300 per parish (six years to date out of a ten-year commitment).

It was suggested that Cllr Annesley, the parish council's memorial hall representative, talk to the hall committee to establish whether this was a potential source of funding for proposed solar roof panels. <u>Action: Cllr Annesley</u>
