18/19 – 046 To receive apologies and approve reasons for absence

18/19 – 047 Declarations of Pecuniary Interests (DPI's) and Other Significant Interests (OSI's) from members concerning specific items on the agenda.

18/19 – 048 Minutes of Meeting of 20 September 2018

18/19 – 049 Vacancy for a Councillor

The Clerk reported that there had been no request from electors to hold a by election to fill this vacancy and that the Parish Council could now seek candidates for co-option.

18/19 – 050 To receive an update from the Anaerobic Digester Working Group

An open letter had been sent to the Governors of Sparsholt College (ref 18/19 - 043). An acknowledgment had been received from the Chief Executive of Winchester City Council who had been copied into the letter. No response had yet been received from the Governors.

18/19 – 051 Village Design Statement – Review and note actions required

Cllrs Wood and Wooles had attended a meeting hosted by Winchester City Council which had predominantly focussed on the Local Plan. It was agreed that the Parish Council's Village Design Statement be reviewed to ensure that it was both relevant and up to date.

18/19 – 052 Public participation

A member of the public joined the meeting to outline his proposed planning application. The application (18/02226/FUL Peonies, Moor Court Lane) had been received after preparation of the agenda and would initially be reviewed by the Planning Advisory Committee. The member of the public was thanked and left the meeting.

18/19 – 053 Parish Plan – update and next actions

Traffic and road safety were a key issue highlighted by the Parish Plan.

Cllr Wooles was due to meet with County Councillor Jan Warwick and Andy Smith, Traffic Management HCC and would specifically highlight the following from the Parish Plan

4.2.3 Change and improve the configurations of some junctions to make them safer to use. Improve sightlines and visibility at some junctions.

Woodman Lane to Watley Lane to be emphasised.

4.2.5 Provide improved signage, where appropriate and better restriction of HGVs using the village and surrounding roads.

As previously noted (18/19 - 029, 18/19 - 042) feedback from HCC related to HGV weight restrictions in certain parts of the village was felt inadequate.

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Feedback would be reported in the next parish newsletter together with an update explaining that 20mph speed limits were not being implemented by the traffic authorities.

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It was noted that following preparation of the agenda the following application had been received 18/02226/FUL Peonies Moor Court Lane Sparsholt SO21 2NQ

The proposal: 1. A replacement garage - single story with pitched roof, room and shower room in the loft space. It is linked with a new entrance/utility/toilet area with continued pitched roof of the existing kitchen. To improve access to the garage and the entrance, the driveway slope is reduced, and the garage floor level is lowered. (garage and link were included in previous application) 2. A replacement conservatory - same area but flat roof replacement. 3. Living room extension to the same line as the replaced conservatory, with sliding doors to connect to south-facing garden. 4. Windows enlargement to bedroom 1 (ground floor) - keep same width but full height to improve natural light. New cladding around the windows and formal entrance - to connect to the rest of alterations/extensions. The Planning Advisory Committee would meet to consider this application and circulate their recommendation to all members of the council for decision. Cllr Little as a neighbour would not participate in this decision.
