24/25 – 13 Apologies: To receive apologies and approve reasons for absence

Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr Little, Cllr Cooper and Cllr Brown.

24/25 – 16 Public Participation

Two members of the parish who are considering becoming Councillors were observing the meeting.

24/25 – 17 Councillor Vacancies

There are currently two vacancies. Two parishioners who are considering the role attended the meeting to observe proceedings. The Councillors and the Clerk introduced themselves and gave a summary of their responsibilities. Cllr Wood gave an overview of the role of the councillors within the parish council.

24/25 – 18 Climate Change

Cllr Cooper was unable to attend the meeting and no update had been received.

24/25 – 19 Traffic through Sparsholt

Traffic report

The road safety working party (RSWP) met and discussed the HCC proposal and presented the current position to Councillors. Current speed limits within the village are inconsistent and need to be considered first, Woodman Lane from Lainston House to the Stockbridge Road, Watley Lane from Locks Lane to Stockbridge Road, Westley Lane from College Farley Nursery to Stockbridge Road, all have national speed limit signs on them and it is recommended that all of them be consistent with 30mph. There is also no speed limit from Sarum Road through Crabwood to Ham Green and it is recommended that this too should be a 30mph area. This would be safer for residents, students at Sparsholt College, cyclists, walkers and horseback riders.

20 mph limit

A 20mph village zone was also discussed and a recommendation made to complete further research. The Clerk is to contact other parishes who have introduced a 20mph zone for feedback on the success or otherwise and for feedback from their residents. City Councillors will also be asked for their input.

If the 20mph matter is to be progressed it will require a Parish Resident meeting to present all the facts and to identify an area for the 20mph zone to be considered. In the meantime costings will be sought from HCC. It is understood that HCC will need to agree to the proposals but the cost will be at the expense of the Parish Council.

In the meantime damaged village signs will be requested to be replaced.

Councillors agreed the recommendations made.

The RSWP will continue discussions with HCC.

There is no update as the meeting with Sparsholt College has been postponed until September.

24/25 – 21 Affordable Housing Update

The building work at Bostock Close is currently out to tender.
