24/25 – 35 Apologies: To receive apologies and approve reasons for absence Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr Little and Cllr Warwick.

24/25 - 37 Minutes of Meeting of 18 July 2024

The minutes had previously been circulated and were approved and signed by the Chair.

24/25 - 38 Public Participation

No members present.

24/25 – 39 Councillor Vacancy

Cllr Hewson had advised the Chair of her resignation. This was accepted and the Clerk has advertised the vacancy and informed WCC. Councillors were asked to consider whether they know any parishioners who may be interested in the position.

24/25 - 40 County and City Councillor's Report

County Councillor Warwick submitted her report ahead of the meeting (see attached). There were no questions or matters arising.

City Councillor had submitted her report ahead of the meeting (see attached).

Cllr Horrill noted that WCC intends to finalise Reg 19 Local Plan ahead of the revised National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF). The NPPF requests an additional 4800 houses in the WCC district, however 40% of this land is in the national park and will not be built on.

Once Reg 19 Local Plan is in, the new plan will start, and there is likely to be a call for sites with settlement gaps being under threat. Cllr Horrill suggested that the parish council talks to the developer who has a proposal for the development on Langham Lane and stated that at the moment this proposal has no status.

The PCSO is to visit the occupant/s of the van parked in the Ham Green car park. This prompted discussion of the ownership of the Ham Green Common Land and whether the parish council can put byelaws in place. Cllr Reid is to look further into the matter. The possibility of signage stating 'no overnight parking' was mentioned.

As Cllr Horrill is Chair of the School Governors, Cllr Wood made her aware that the school bus has been reversing into Church Lane to turn rather than using Woodman Close. This caused congestion in both directions on Woodman Lane and in Church Lane. Cllr Horrill agreed to have a word with the school and the Bus Company.

Cerda have undertaken a public consultation for a potential housing development on Lanham Lane.

When Cllr Wood attended the latest Local Plan meeting to ask about the parish council request for the strategic gap, she was told there was no need because in Reg 19 there is no proposed development close to Sparsholt. Councillors agreed that this should still be pursued when giving our feedback to the Reg 19 Consultation. Cllr Horrill suggested that a member of the parish council meet with the developers.

24/25 - 45Local Plan - Reg 19

The consultation period for Winchester City Council's Proposed Submission Local Plan, Regulation 19, is open until 13 October 2024. Councillors are to look at the plan and any agreed comments will be submitted.

24/25 - 46

Cllr Walthoe had circulated comprehensive information about three possible options regarding traffic and road signage for consideration. These are summarised below:

- Repair the existing signage that is damaged or missing. c. £3,200.
- Repair existing signage and implement additional elements as suggested by Hampshire Traffic Engineer. c. £16,000 in addition to the repair cost in item 1.

The items suggested by the Traffic Engineer include:

- Village "gateways" either side of the village.
- Updated road lines including 30mph "roundels" painted on the road.
- Updated signage including "horses" or "pedestrians".
- Implement additional measures to reduce the impact of traffic on Sparsholt and Crab Wood. £TBC. At least a year for consultation and implementation. This considers 20mph and extended 30mph zones. There are criteria that need to be satisfied in order that a 20mph limit can be put in place. **Action: All Councillors**

Councillors are to consider the report and discuss at the October meeting.
